Small and medium sized businesses
- Owners: The Ministry of Trade, Industry and Fisheries owns 51 %, the county municipalities own 49 %
- Established by law with its own board

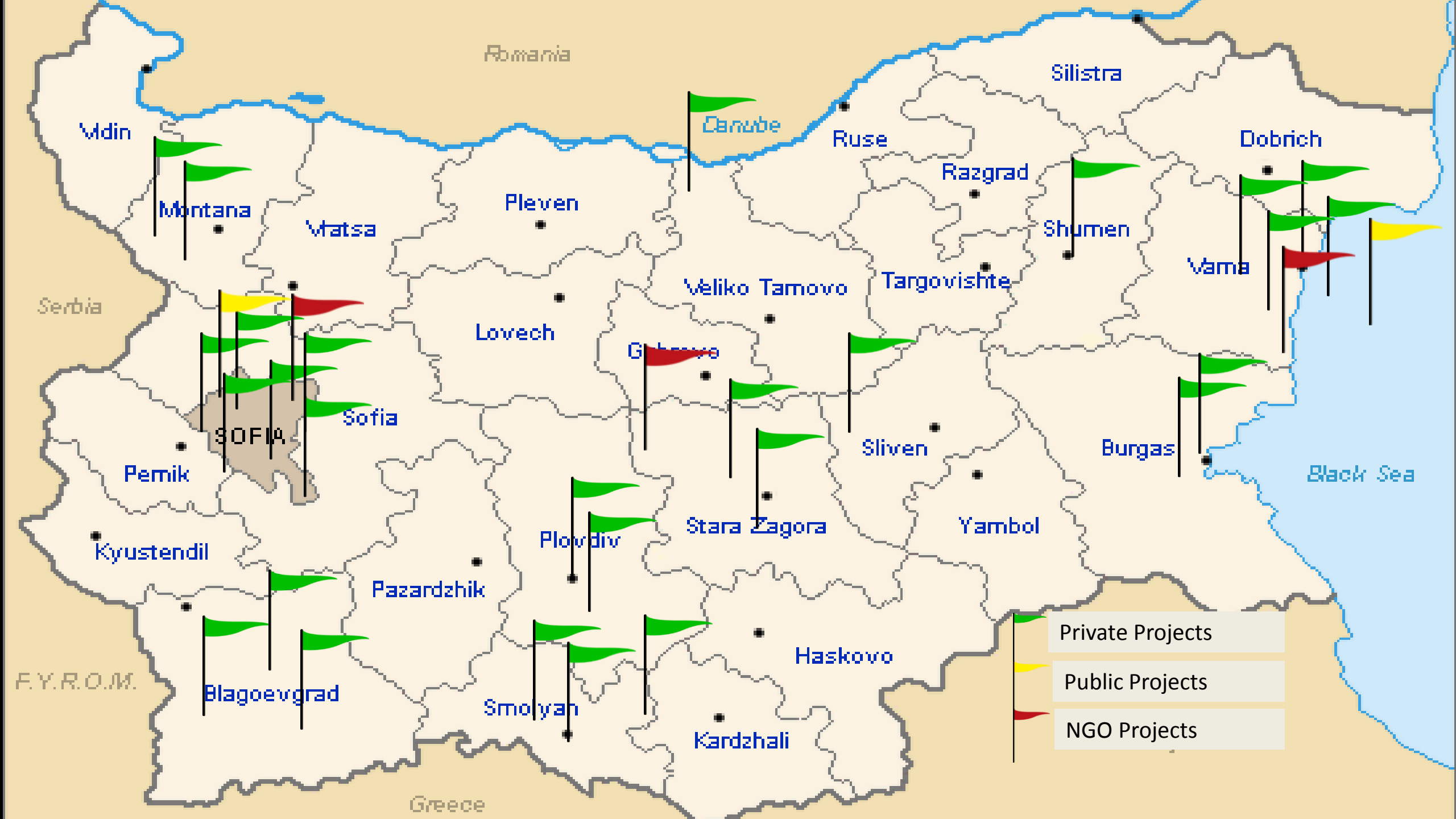

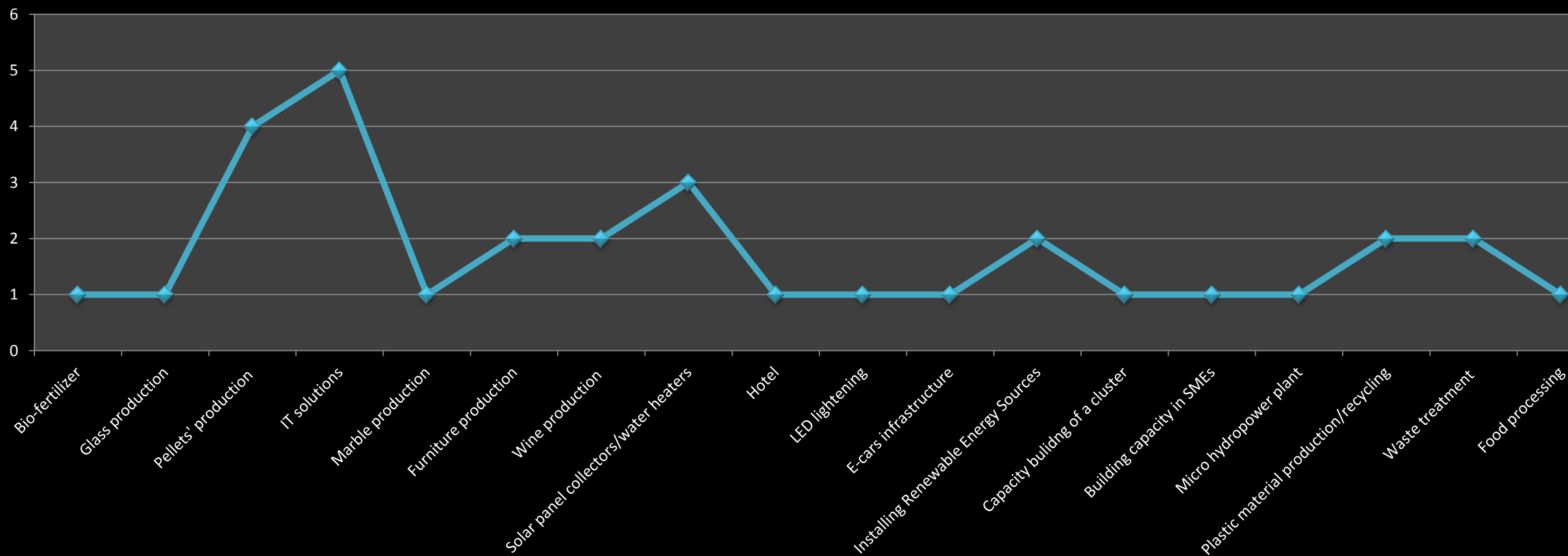
