PROGRAMME OBJECTIVE:

To strengthened institutional capacity and human resource development in Bulgarian public institutions, local and regional authorities through cooperation and transfer of knowledge with similar institutions and authorities in Norway

• MAIN FOCUS:

The programme sets a platform for capacity building, development of modern and efficient public administration at central and local level and improvement of public services, through the implementation of two pre-defined projects



- PROGRAMME BUDGET: The contribution from the Norwegian Financial Mechanism is 2 016 000 EUR. The overall budget of the programme is 2 371 765 EUR.

- Exchange of experience and transfer of knowledge between the partners for better understanding of cross-border issues
- Promotion of good cross-border relations, fostering stable and secure growth, encouraging balanced and sustainable development
- Generation of data on cross-border relations and competency among journalists and think tank experts for adequate media coverage and analysis of the situation in the border regions



• What are our goals?

The cooperation between the counterparts shall contribute to development of networks, exchange of knowledge and dissemination of best practices. It shall provide a framework for administrations and public authorities in Bulgaria to cooperate with their counterparts in Norway, with the aim of developing modern and efficient administration.

TIMELINE

Implementation of the projects is planned for a period of 4 years and it is envisaged to start at the end of 2012.
