What are we financing?

- ✓ Improvement of material conditions of detention in the Bulgarian penitentiary institutions;
- ✓ Expanding the scope of alternative measures by introducing electronic monitoring;
- ✓ Increased prison staff competence, practical skills and knowledge
- ✓ More effective reintegration of sentenced persons;
- ✓ Activities targeting vulnerable groups` specific needs aimed at reintegration through building skills and improving capacity.

Who can apply ?

Under a small grant scheme the eligible beneficiaries will be NGOs, training institutes, leading experts.

All projects financed by the Program will be implemented in partnership with the Council of Europe, using the expertise of Bulgarian and international NGOs, international organizations, academics and leading experts.

Our ambitions

To improve the penitentiary system in Bulgaria in compliance with the relevant international human rights instruments.
